


# **Annual Report Fiscal Year 2016**

# Our Programs

**Goffstown Area Juvenile Court Diversion:** An accredited program for first-time offenders using restorative justice practices to hold youth accountable for their actions outside of the court system.

**VolunTEENS:** A program connecting students in grades 7-12 to local volunteer opportunities helping them learn valuable life skills and build healthy networks while nurturing a culture of service.

**Youth Forums:** Dynamic, monthly roundtable discussion groups of community leaders and youth working together to identify needs and build strong community assets for healthy youth and families. Now in our 23<sup>rd</sup> year at GHS and 2<sup>nd</sup> year at MVMS, these forums are exemplary prevention models.


Youth Attendant Program: Provides temporary care for juveniles who are in custody, but not under arrest.

**Financial Aid:** We provide income-based assistance for local youth so they may have access to out-of-school time programs and activities that enrich their lives and keep them safe.

**Community Series:** *NEW THIS YEAR* we are proud to introduce a series of free informational workshops to arm local adults with the knowledge they need to help keep our kids healthy and safe. Topics include Suicide Prevention, Substance Misuse, Internet Safety, Parenting and more.

**Partnerships:** We are active participants in the Suicide Prevention Initiative, regional Substance Misuse Prevention Initiatives, the New Hampshire Juvenile Court Diversion Network and the biennial Youth Risk Behavior Survey. These partnerships enable us to better identify needs, gather resources and deliver high-caliber programming to the greater Goffstown community.

Crispin's House Coalition for Youth, as a tax-exempt non-profit organization, annually files a Form 990 with the Internal Revenue Service to provide information to the public on the organization's finances, public support, and activities. The Town of Goffstown's support of a Warrant Article in the amount of \$20,000 received in July of 2016 has been instrumental in our ability to prepare to serve more at-risk youth in Goffstown.
