Fast Facts

Types of electronic nicotine delivery systems (ENDS)

- > E-cigarettes
- > E-cigars
- Vaporizers
- > Vape pens
- ➤ Hookah pens

Electronic cigarettes are not an FDA approved quit aid!

Components:

- 1. A cartridge which holds a liquid solution containing varying amounts of nicotine, flavoring and chemicals ('e-juice')
- 2. A heating element (vaporizer)
- 3. A power source (battery)

New Regulations

- Must be 18 years or older to purchase; must show identification
- Warning label required on all new products stating it contains nicotine, an addictive chemical
- FDA now regulates manufacturing, packaging, labeling, sales and marketing

Mild Poisoning

- Nausea with or without vomiting
- Dizziness
- Headache
- > Tremor
- > Sweating
- > Pale skin
- > Hyperactivity
- > Anxiety
- > Increased heart rate
- Increased blood pressure
- > Irritability

Not just a Harmless Water Vapor

- E-Cigarettes may contain liquid nicotine which is highly addictive
- Other ingredients include flavorings, propylene glycol and glycerin
- If spilled on skin, e-juice may be absorbed and cause a poisoning
- Flavors are appealing to children and refill bottles present potential for a deadly exposure to a child or pet
- Long term health effects are unknown

Safety Tips

- Keep liquid nicotine and ecigarettes up and away from children and pets
- Store liquid nicotine in child resistant containers
- Protect your skin when handling liquid nicotine

Severe Poisoning

- Irregular heart beat
- Seizures
- Chest pain
- Slow heart rate
- Low blood pressure
- Loss of consciousness
- Paralysis
 - Trouble breathing
- Confusion
- Weakness
